Ancient Farmhouse with Oil mill

Overview

This beautiful property is located in the historical centre of Giuliano di Lecce, a village characterised by an ancient castle dating back to the 16th century, a menhir that preserves the history of the village and an ancient underground oil mill built in 1789.

The hypogeum oil mill is obviously located in the basement and still preserves a beautiful stone millstone and the milling vat.

On the ground floor is the machinery used for milling olives.







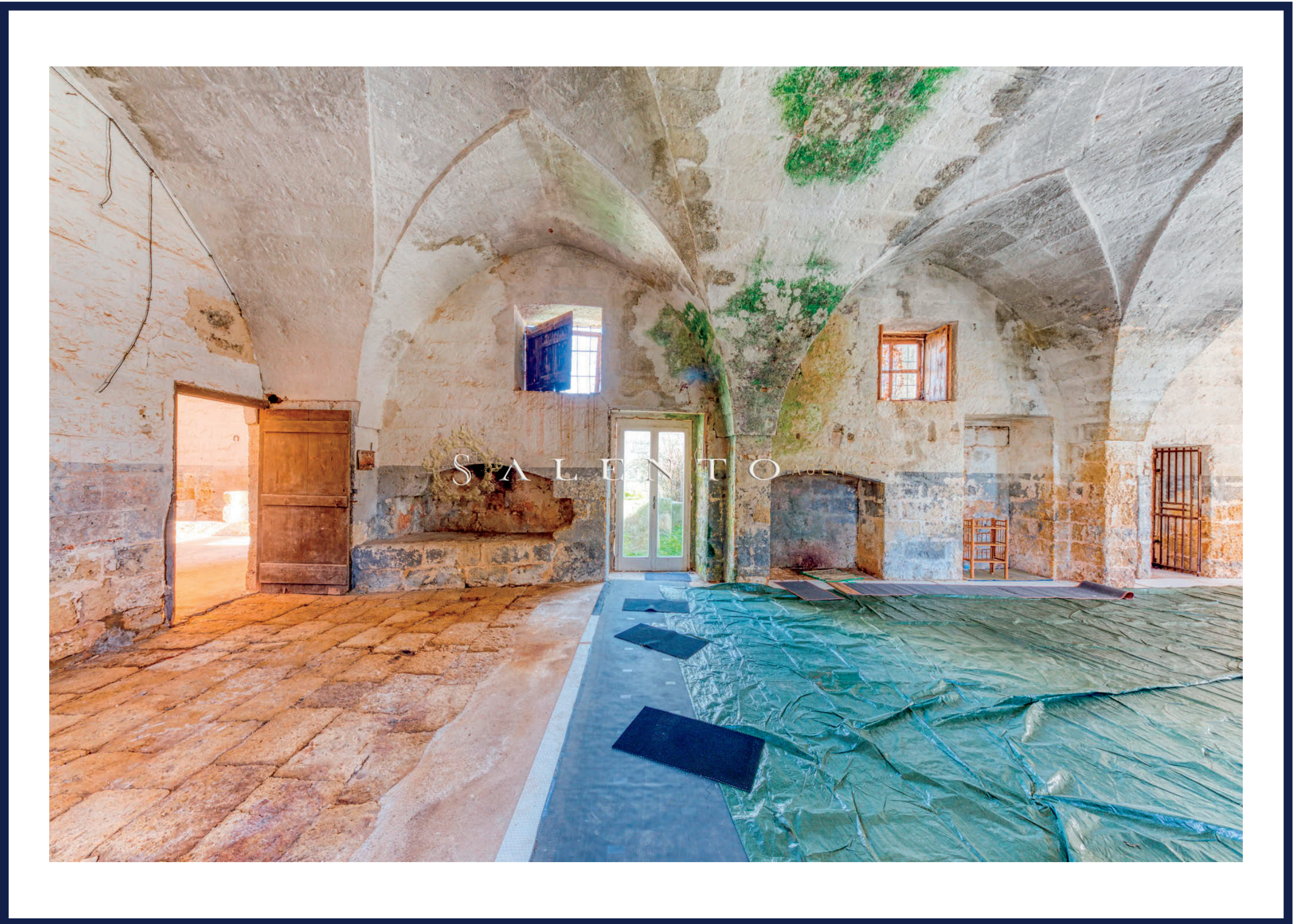


Interior

Large rooms with typical star vaults were used for the hydraulic presses, while a room with a barrel vault and fireplace was the accountant's office.

A second large room with a triple star vault was the room where the olives to be pressed were stored, and adjacent to it were two rooms with Lecce stone tanks where the oil produced was stored.





The external

A large courtyard separated the processing rooms with the three rooms for livestock and farm implements.

At the back is a large garden of 400 metres, accessible from Via Frosinone.
